Types of SCHEDULES and COSTS

TYPES OF SCHEDULE:

PART TIME: 09:00-14:00

FULL TIME: 09:00-17:00

PART TIME FEES:

1 week-125 euro (meals included: breakfast, fruit snack and lunch)

4 weeks— 490 euro (meals included: breakfast, fruit snack and lunch)

FULL TIME FEES:

1 week— 160 euro (meals included: breakfast, fruit snack, lunch and afternoon snack)

4 weeks— 600 euro (meals included: breakfast, fruit snack, lunch and afternoon snack)

The costs will not change if the child does not attend the classes. The given costs include the educational activities and the meals, but not the extra clubs (swimming, tennis, squash, padel, golf).
