Types of SCHEDULES and COSTS

TYPES OF SCHEDULE:

PART TIME: 09:00-13:30

FULL TIME: 09:00-17:00

PART TIME FEES:

1 week— 150 euro (meals included: breakfast, fruit snack and lunch)

5 weeks— 728 euro (meals included: breakfast, fruit snack and lunch)

6 weeks— 864 euro (meals included: breakfast, fruit snack and lunch)

FULL TIME FEES:

1 week— 190 euro (meals included: breakfast, 2 snacks and lunch)

5 weeks— 922 euro (meals included: breakfast, 2 snacks and lunch)

6 weeks— 1095 euro (meals included: breakfast, 2 snacks and lunch)

The total fixed cost remains the same even if the child does not attend all classes. The total fixed cost includes the meals and all educational activities, except from the extra clubs (swimming, physical education, gymnastics, dance).
